

# Victoria – Saanich CADORA Society 2019 Horse Council BC Recognized Dressage Show Series ENTRY FORM

#### SHOW RULES & INFORMATION

#### VSCadora is running both Bronze and HCBC classes at the same show. HCBC tests will be ridden in the AM.

- Victoria Saanich CADORA Society Dressage Series Shows are Horse Council BC Recognized Events and will be governed by the HCBC Rule Book. The HCBC Rule Book can be found here: <a href="http://www.hcbc.ca/index.php/competitions/competition-documents/">http://www.hcbc.ca/index.php/competitions/competition-documents/</a>.
- The shows are BC Heritage Circuit qualifiers and BC Summer Games qualifiers.
- 3. Entry priority will be given to CADORA members up to the entry closing date. Late entries will be accommodated when possible and non-CADORA entrants will be given equal priority after closing date.
- 4. Competitors must include payment, entry form, volunteer sign-up form and proof (photocopy) of current HCBC membership for entries to be accepted. Note: proof of HCBC membership is required only with your first show entry of the year.
- 5. **RIDE TIMES** Ride times will be posted on the website (<a href="www.vscadora.com">www.vscadora.com</a>) and the VSCadora facebook page by the Wednesday evening before the show. Please allow time for your ride to be a maximum of 15 minutes early in case of scratches.
- 6. **REFUNDS -** For scratches prior to the entry close date full refund of entry fees. For scratches after the entry close date entry fee refund only on presentation of a veterinarian's or physician's certificate.
- 7. Competitors may enter up to three tests, entries permitting.
- 8. **ENTRIES** OPEN one month prior to the show date and CLOSE on the Monday 2 weeks prior to the show. Entries received after the closing date will be entered in the show if there is space. HOWEVER entries received later than the Monday 1 week before the show will NOT be accepted. **NO EARLY ENTRIES ACCEPTED.**
- 9. **VOLUNTEERING** all riders must be available to provide assistance with the running of the show.
- 10. Anyone may ride in the Open category. No cross entry between Junior and Amateur categories.
- 11. Riders may enter to ride the same test more than once, however only the first score will count.
- 12. TESTS OFFERED:
  - a. Equestrian Canada Tests of Choice- Intro through Fourth Level 2019 tests
  - b. FEI Test of Choice
  - c. Western Dressage Tests American Version.
  - d. Para Dressage Tests
- 13. **SCHOOLING RIDES (NEW)** Riders may enter to ride a schooling ride in the dressage arena. Schooling rides will not be judged and riders will have the option to ride a complete test, work on specific movements or simply familiarize their horses with the competition arena. Schooling rides will be scheduled throughout the day in the breaks but will only be offered if time is available and competitive tests will have priority. Schooling riders will be expected to fulfill the same volunteer requirements as competitive riders. If riders do a schooling ride before their test please note that the test following will be as a non competitor.
- 14. NUMBERS Identification numbers must be worn and visible at all times while at the competition site.
- 15. **HEADGEAR** All riders, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at the competition site.
- 16. **RIBBONS** awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Classes with only one entry will have ribbons awarded based on percentage score. No ribbons awarded for scores under 50%.
- 17. AWARDS Year-end awards are based on the three highest scores achieved at the same level for the same horse/rider combination scored by three different judges (at HCBC Recognized Series or Capital City Classic Show). Only Victoria Saanich CADORA Society members are eligible for club awards and riders must have volunteered for CADORA functions/competitions during the year to qualify for awards.
- 18. If stabling is needed please contact the competition manager
- 19. VS Cadora does not provide a place for lunging. The indoor ring may be available but must be arranged for with the Saanich Fairgrounds by the competitor. NO unauthorized lunging is allowed

#### Options for Volunteering at a Victoria Saanich CADORA Society Dressage Series Show:

- 1. Show up and do the volunteer shift yourself
- 2. Persuade a reliable friend or family member to cover your assigned shift. The rider MUST notify the Show Manager of the name and contract information of the designated volunteer. The rider remains responsible for ensuring the volunteer shift is covered
- 3. Build up some 'volunteer goodwill' by volunteering to help at a show you are not riding in. All volunteer time at the shows will be recorded and taken into account by the Show Manager when setting the volunteer schedule. When possible, riders who have not yet volunteered will be scheduled ahead of those who have already helped at a show.
