This Victoria Saanich CADORA Society Dressage Show is a Horse Council BC Recognized Event and will be governed by the

#### Horse Welfare Statement 2020 HCBC Rule Book

Horse Council BC members are responsible for the well-being and humane treatment of any equine entrusted to their care. Every horse at an HCBC approved event shall, at all times, be treated humanely and with dignity, respect, and compassion. The welfare of the horse is paramount. Any inhumane treatment or the abuse of a horse by any person at an approved HCBC show is forbidden. The obligation and responsibility to handle horses you own, use or that are in your care, with skill and compassion; ensuring, regardless of value, that they are not subjected to abuse, neglect or mistreatment. Horses used in competition, spectator events, shows, or exhibitions must not be subjected to unscrupulous use of medications, non-nutritive agents, equipment or procedures that may alter performance, appearance or natural function. It is strongly recommended that horses be up to date on vaccinations and in good health to perform. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition practices would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

- VS CADORA is running these shows as combined HCBC and EC Bronze shows. All HCBC classes will be held before the EC Bronze classes.
- 3. If entries warrant, we will run a 1/2 day HCBC show on Saturday afternoon. Please indicate on your form if you would be able to ride on Saturday instead of Sunday.
- 4. **ENTRIES:** OPEN one month prior to the show date and CLOSE on Saturday 1 week prior to the show. Entries received after the closing date will be entered in the show if there is space. HOWEVER, entries received later than the Monday 1 week before the show will NOT be accepted. **NO EARLY ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** 
  - Entries MUST be emailed. NO drop off or mailed entries will be accepted.
  - Entries will be limited with priority given to VS CADORA members up to the entry closing date.
  - Entries will only be accepted by e-mail attachment which must include a copy of the entry form; e-transfer of funds due and proof (photocopy) of current HCBC membership for entries to be accepted.
- 5. Competitors may enter up to two tests per horse, entries permitting.
- 6. If anyone other than the rider (e.g., Coach, trainer, owner) is going to exercise or warm up the horse, that person must bring a signed waiver and proof of HCBC membership to the Show office on arrival at the venue.
- 7. **RIDE TIMES:** Ride times will be posted on the website (<a href="www.vscadora.com">www.vscadora.com</a>) and the VSCadora Facebook page by the Wednesday evening before the show. No changes will be made to the times once posted. Please allow time for your ride to be a maximum of 15 minutes early in case of scratches.
- 8. **WARM-UP:** The warmup ring for the shows is the indoor arena. The rider on deck will be allowed in the outdoor ring to continue their warmup before their test. Under no circumstances may a rider be inside the competition ring unless they are performing their test in front of the Judge. EXCEPTION When the rider has paid for and been given a scheduled schooling ride it will not be judged.
- 9. Rules specific to the warm-up area:
  - no hand walking allowed
  - please ride left hand to left hand
  - horses being ridden at the walk are required to leave the rail free for horses trotting or cantering
  - coaches must stand outside the ring while coaching
  - the Whipper-In is in charge of conduct in the warm-up area and has the authority to excuse a horse/rider combination from the area if they are perceived as a possible safety threat to themselves or other riders

#### **HCBC School Show Rules and Information (continued)**

- 10. **REFUNDS:** For scratches prior to the entry close date full refund of entry fees. For scratches after the entry close date entry fee refund only on presentation of a veterinarian or physician certificate.
- 11. **VOLUNTEERING:** all riders must be available to provide assistance with the running of the show.
- 12. Anyone may ride in the Open category. No cross entry between Junior and Amateur categories.
- 13. Riders may enter to ride the same test more than once, however only the first score will count.
- 14. **TESTS OFFERED**:
  - a. Equestrian Canada Tests of Choice- Intro through Fourth Level (2023)
  - b. FEI Test of Choice
  - c. Western Dressage Tests American Version.
  - d. Para Dressage Tests
  - e. MASTERS TOC Class- open to riders 60 and over. Please write Masters after your chosen test on the form.
- 15. **SCHOOLING RIDES** Will only be available if time permits after entries close. Riders may enter to ride a 10 min schooling ride in the dressage arena. Schooling rides will not be judged and riders will have the option to ride a complete test, work on specific movements or simply familiarize their horses with the competition arena. Schooling rides will be scheduled throughout the day in the breaks but will only be offered if time is available and competitive tests will have priority. Schooling riders will be expected to fulfill the same volunteer requirements as competitive riders. If riders do a schooling ride before their test, please note that the test following will be as a non-competitor.
- 16. **NUMBERS** Identification numbers must be worn and visible at all times while at the competition site.
- 17. **HEADGEAR** All riders, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear properly fitted and fastened safety approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at the event location.
- 18. **RIBBONS** Ribbons are awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place. No ribbons will be awarded for scores under 50 percent.
- 19. AWARDS Year-end awards are based on the three highest scores achieved at the same level with the same horse/rider combination scored by three different judges. Only Victoria-Saanich CADORA Society members are eligible for club awards.
- 20. No stabling will be available.
- 21. Zilversprings Farm does not provide a place for lunging. NO unauthorized lunging is allowed.
- 22. NO dogs are allowed anywhere on the property.
- 23. Entry to show grounds is from Central Saanich Rd. only.
