



VS Cadora Awards - 2022

Annual Awards @ 2022

Champion and Reserve Champion Awards will be presented annually for each of the three separate rider categories i.e. Junior; Adult Amateur and Open in the following Levels:

EC Introductory; Training; First; Second; Third and Fourth Levels

Champion and Reserve Champion Awards will also be presented for:

FEI – Amateur
FEI – Open
FEI - Youth to include Children, Pony and Junior
FEI - Young Rider

Champion and Reserve Champion awards will also be presented for:

Para Dressage: EC Bronze - Open
Para Equestrian: FEI TOC - Open

Western: Tests of Choice -Open

For all annual awards, riders must be paid up VSC members before the first or their first competition of the current year and have:

- ridden at 3 different VS Cadora competitions, at the same level under 3 different judges.
- Calculation based on: the highest aggregate of the three highest scores of the same horse/rider combination at each level.

Junior Rider Award

Initiated in 2019 using \$500.00 received from the final distribution of funds from Cadora BC, this Junior Rider Award was established with the intent to continue the award once these 'start' funds have been used.

This is not a competitive award, it is open to all junior riders who have competed in three tests judged by three different judges at any of the VSC competitions during the current year. The three tests may be ridden on different ponies/horses.

At the annual awards banquet, the names of all eligible junior riders will be entered in a 'draw' for a \$100.00 cash prize and handsome rosette. In addition to the 'draw', all eligible junior riders will receive a 'Free Test Fee Certificate' for any VSC competition in the coming year.

Perpetual Awards @ 2022

Awards will be made based on the specialty stated but subject to the same criteria as for the annual awards that is:

- ridden at 3 different VS Cadora competitions at the same level under 3 different judges.
- Calculation based on: the highest aggregate of the three highest scores of the same horse/rider combination at each level.

*It is the responsibility of the perpetual award winners to return any trophy won, to the Awards Co-ordinator when requested after the last competition of the season.

Criteria are either of:
FEI Child or Pony: highest average of 3 scores over 62% from 3 different judges or:
FEI Junior or Young Riders: highest average of 3 scores of 62% from 3 different judges.

*The score requirements have been adjusted this year from the 63% and 60% respectively to 62% for each grouping. The reasoning for this is not one of simplicity only but, because the test equivalency for FEI Pony and Children is Second Level; Junior is Third Level; Young Rider is PSG. The minimum scores for a VSC Gold medal at these levels under our 2022 rules is 62%. In 2023, the wording will state:
FEI Youth - Child, Pony, Junior and Young Rider: highest average of 3 scores at or over 62% from 3 different judges.

Nominated Annual Awards

VICTORIA SAANICH CADORA RIDE ON AWARD (formerly the CIBC RIDE ON AWARD)
VSC Directors to nominate a rider at any VSC show who handles a problem in or outside the competition arena with 'exemplary skill, style and tact'. Winners of this award will be determined by the total number of votes. A brief description of the event is required with the nomination.

VICTORIA SAANICH CADORA VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR (formerly the CIBC VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR) VSC Directors to nominate a person who has volunteered for the club and displayed vision, teamwork, tenacity and a positive attitude. A nominee may not have received any remuneration for their services. A brief description of the nominee with the nomination.

MARGOT PARKER MEMORIAL – GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD'

VSC Directors to nominate persons who they believe have exhibited good sportsmanship during the past year.

Victoria Saanich Cadora also has its' own annual 'Medal Program'

* Please note that the percentages required in our medal program has been updated this year to the percentages used for both EC and Cadora Inc.Awards programs.

This is a program for all riders regardless of age or level. It enables each rider to compete and look forward to achieving an annual goal at the level they ride in. There are Gold, Silver and Bronze medals awarded to horse/rider combinations competing at 3 separate VSC competitions under 3 separate judges at each of the following levels:

Introductory, Training, First and Para Dressage

Gold: 3 scores at or over 65%
Silver: 3 scores between 62% - 64.99%
Bronze: 3 scores between 59% - 61.99%

Second; Third; Fourth and FEI Youth and Open:

Gold: 3 scores at or over 62%
Silver: 3 scores between 59% - 61.99%
Bronze: 3 scores between 56% - 58.99%

If scores from a panel are used, only the final score may be used.

No horse/rider combination may win the same medal more than once.

Medals have the V-S CADORA logo on one side and on the other, the year, test level, name of the horse/rider combination.

The names of award winners will be announced at the year-end banquet and medals may be picked up then.
